## M.S. IN FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES

### Minimum Total Hours for Degree: 36

**Description:** The Master of Science (MS) degree program in Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) at the University of Mississippi is designed to prepare students for doctoral studies in nutrition, food service management, or hospitality management; for postsecondary teaching positions; and for careers in established or emerging clinical, community-based, or industrial settings. The program has two emphasis areas: 1) Nutrition, and 2) Hospitality Management.

**Degree Requirements:** The program consists of 36 post-baccalaureate credit hours, of which up to 6 credit hours may be transferred from another university. The requirements for the M.S. degree are: 9 hours of core requirements; 9 hours of emphasis area core requirements; 12-15 hours of electives; and 3-6 hours of directed research or 6 hours of thesis.
